ENTRY PROCESS

The entry process for Bend The Air depends on which section you are entering. Entry for acrobatics & circus routines is a direct entry process and can be completed by filling out the entry form, paying the registration and routine fee and uploading your music file online. Our Aerial categories undergo a two-phase entry process which involves a video audition. This process is to ensure safety and correct categorisation of routines.

Aerial Routine Entry Process



Step 1: Video Audition

- Film your routine in studio, or submit a previous performance piece.
- Pay the competitor registration fee & submit your form & video online
- Receive results via email within 7 days. If successful, complete step 2.





- Complete the online form, which gives us specific info about your routine including apparatus use.
- Pay routine entry fees
- Upload music file

PROFESSIONAL RIGGER

A qualified rigger is present throughout all aerial sessions to oversee every aspect of the rigging process, ensuring adherence to industry standards and safety protocols, providing confidence to all participants.



CUSTOM SAFETY MAT

Our custom-designed, round safety mat and carpeted 6x6m acromat flooring are used for all aerial sections. These mats have been specifically designed to cushion landings and minimise the risk of injury during aerial performances.



CERTIFIED EQUIPMENT


All equipment used at Bend The Air competitions must be certified for aerial use. All in house apparatus are purchased from reputable suppliers with certification documentation. All BYO gear must come with certification and will undergo an inspection prior to being rigged for the competition.
